It has excellent disease resistance to gray leaf spot making this cultivar one of your best choices for an all-around cool season turfgrass. Rest assured with excellent winter color in cool temperatures Gray Eagle SLT will give you the leg up when preparing for the season ahead.

Geographical Adaption:

Gray Eagle SLT has extreme salt tolerance (SLT), making it a good choice for areas with high levels of salinity. It is frequently used for fall/winter overseeding of dormant Bermuda in the south. Seeding rates for home and landscape use range from 7-10 lbs./1,000 sq. ft. (340-490 kg/ha). For athletic fields, golf course overseeding, and sod farms a range of 450-650 lbs./acre (500-730 kg/ha) is adequate. Gray Eagle SLT can handle mowing heights from .25" to 2.5" (1.27-10 cm) while keeping exceptional turf density.
