Testing Criteria

- 1) Must be available as certified seed
- 2) Must be tested at sites in both Maryland & Virginia
- 3) Must perform well, relative to other varieties, for a minimum of two years to make the list as a “promising” variety and for three years to make the “recommended” category.

Pure Seed Research Locations

- PST WEST (Canby, OR): 200+ acres of R & D
- PST EAST (Rolesville, NC): 25 acres of R & D
- PST WORLD: varieties in 200+ trials around the world
